## Multiethnic Advocates for Cultural Competence, Inc.

The Multiethnic Advocates for Cultural Competence, Inc (MACC) is a 501(c)3 not-for-profit statewide membership organization.

MACC was established in 2003 to make cultural competence a cornerstone in Ohio's behavioral health system. A 20-member board of directors governs the organization.

Six of MACC'S board members are standing representatives for the following organizations: NAMI (state and local); Ohio Council of Behavioral Health Care Providers; Ohio Association of County Behavioral Health Authorities; Ohio Psychological Association; Ohio Psychiatric Physicians Association; and the Ohio Federation for Children's Mental Health.

The additional board members represent racial, ethnic and cultural communities as well as professional disciplines throughout the state that care for vulnerable populations. They are nominated and elected by the membership.

All people in Ohio's behavioral health and other care systems experience and practice cultural competence that leads to optimal outcomes, providing a model for change.
